Fundraising Ideas

The most successful teams use a combined approach of individual and team fundraising. Below are suggestions to increase your fundraising efforts:

- It's summer host a car wash or a lemonade stand.
- Ask for donations in lieu of birthday or anniversary gifts.
- Host a casual day at the office. Each employee who wishes to "dress down" has to make a minimum donation to your team.
- Provide change jars for your team members and ask them to toss in their spare change. It adds up!
- Send creative emails to everyone in your address book and ask them to visit your team page to make a donation.
- ➡ Host a fundraising night at a local restaurant that will donate a percentage of the night's sales to your team.
- Ask your supporters to inquire about matching gifts with their employers. Some employers double, and even triple, contributions made by their employees.
- Ask businesses you frequent, like your hair dresser, barber, nail salon, local shop or restaurant, doctor, dentist, or gym for donations.
- Obtain some donated items and hold an auction or raffle.
- Hold a garage/yard sale and display signs that state proceeds benefit your Race for Our Kids team. You might receive some extra donations!
- Host a bake sale.
- Fill a jar with jellybeans or M&M's and charge people to guess how many are in the container. The closest guess wins the candy jar.
- Spread the word about your team on facebook, twitter, instagram, etc.
